Discussion Questions

• Opener: Do you feel blessed? Why or why not?

Read Ephesians 1:3-14

- 1. What do we learn about God's big plan in these verses?
- 2. What roles do the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit play in this plan?
- 3. What is the ultimate goal of God's big plan? (cf. 6, 12, 14)
- 4. Christians often speak of "God's will" in terms of personal 'guidance' e.g. which job I shoud take, who to marry etc. In Ephesians 1, God's "will" refers to his big plan to save his people and bring himself glory.
- 5. How might understand God's big plan actually help us when it comes to making important decisions in life?
- 6. How does focusing on God's big plan keep us from becoming discouraged when our plans fail?
- 7. How can we help each other remember the big picture Paul paints?

Read verses 3-6 again

- 1. According to these verses, in what specific ways has God blessed us?
- 2. How do these verses point to the fact that we contribute nothing to our salvation?
 - a. We often forget the fact that we contribute nothing. We begin to believe we are worthy or deserve something from God. How might this explain why we don't *feel* blessed?
 - b. If God has blessed you by loving and choosing you when you didn't deserve it, what should you attitude be: i) toward God ii) toward other people?
- 3. Spend some time now praising God for all of the ways he has blessed you, including the fact that he has loved you and chosen you.
- 4. Think of one practical way to show undeserved, God-like kindness to someone else before we meet again. Pray for God to open up a door for you to point that person to Him.
