Mark 14:1-31 Discussion Questions

Opener: Are we experiencing an "highly coordinated, deliberate and systematic attack" on Christianity in our time?

Humanity's evil plans

- 1. What role do each of the following play in Jesus' crucifixion:
 - a. The religious leaders (Read vv. 1-2)
 - b. Judas (Read vv. 10-11)
 - c. The disciples (Read vv. 26-31)
- 2. How do we witness the same, varying degrees of opposition to Jesus today?
- 3. How do you feel when people either directly or subtly oppose Christianity? Why do you feel this way?

God's eternal purposes

- 1. Skim through Mark 14:1-31 and note down all the evidence that God is ultimately the one in control (if you need help look at vv. 8-9, 12-16, 21, 22-25, 27-28)
- 2. Why will the woman's act of devotion be remembered? (v. 9)
- 3. What is the significance of the fact that all of this is taking place at Passover?
- 4. God is using humanity's evil plots to advance his eternal purposes. How should knowing this about God encourage us:
 - a. When we experience direct opposition like that of the religious leaders
 - b. When people who once walked with Jesus turn their backs in him like Judas
 - c. When fellow believers let us down like the disciples

Prayer ideas:

- Each share about a way that you are experiencing opposition for your faith either directly or more subtly.
- Give thanks that God is in control in each situation and pray that he turns things on their head so they serve to advance his kingdom.
