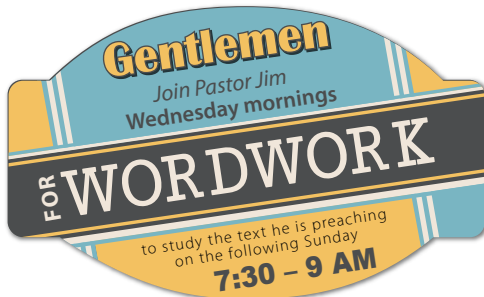
would you like to serve the hurricane victims?

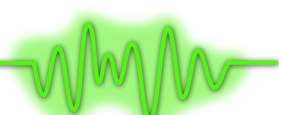
