# **Discussion Questions**

## Jesus is fulfills God's promises

#### Read Mark 11:1-10

- 1. What evidence is there that everything is happening just as God had said? (cf. Zechariah 9:9)
- 2. Why does this matter, given what's about to happen to Jesus and his disciples?

## Jesus exposes the failure of God's people

## Read Mark 11:11-19

- 3. How is the fig tree (vv. 12-14) a picture of what's going on in the temple (vv. 15-19)?
- 4. What is Jesus verdict on the tree (and therefore on Israel's false religion)?
- 5. What 'fruit' does Jesus look for in the lives of his followers? (See e.g. Mark 8:34; 9:7, 29, 35-27; 10:15, 43-45 and also Galatians 5:22-23)
- 6. If Jesus were to visit your home, workplace, or our church, do you think he would find the fruit he's looking for?
- 7. Think of 2-3 examples of what it would look like to be more fruitful in each of these areas.

## Jesus calls for faith in God's provision

#### Read Mark 11:20-24

- 8. Jesus arrival marks the end of the road for the temple and Old Testament sacrifices. According to verses 23-25, how are we meant to relate to God now these things are gone?
- 9. What has Jesus done to remove the 'mountain' that stands between us and God? (See Mark 10:45)

#### **Prayer Ideas:**

Thank God that he loves us enough to exposes our sin and also do everything it takes to save us from it.
