notes

1. Loving one another radically is more important than spiritual gifts, Biblical knowledge and acts of service (vv. 1-3)
2. Loving one another radically is multi-faceted, self-less and others-centered (vv. 4-6)
3. Loving one another radically outshines, endures, and perfects (vv. 8-13)
