confessing our sin

God the Spirit reminds us that God the Father has saved us through the righteous life and sacrificial death of Christ the Son - and in faith we rest on his gracious interest to renew us yet again.

we hear. from Romans 8:12-16

(leader) So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

we confess . from the Valley of Vision

(all) Father, when you are angry towards me for my wrongs, I try to pacify you by abstaining from future sin;

But teach me that I cannot satisfy your law, that this effort is a resting in my righteousness, that only Christ's righteousness, ready made, already finished, is for that purpose; that your chastising me for my sin is not that I should try to reform, but only that I may be more humbled, afflicted, and separated from sin,

by being reconciled, and made righteous in Christ by faith. Amen.
