(leader)

How many things are necessary for thee to know, that thou, enjoying this comfort, mayest live and die happily?

(all)

Three. First, how great my sins and miseries are; second, how I may be delivered from all my sins and miseries; and third, how I shall express my gratitude to God for such deliverance.
