For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God!

confessing our sin

God the Spirit reminds us that God the Father has saved us through the righteous life and sacrificial death of Christ the Son - and in faith we rest on his gracious interest to renew us yet again.

we hear. from the Heidelberg Catechism, q.1-2 (1563)

(leader) What is your only comfort in life and in death?

(all) That I am not my own, but belong—body and soul, in life and in death—to my faithful Savior Jesus Christ. He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from the tyranny of the devil. He also watches over me in such a way that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven: in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.

(leader) What must you know to live and die in the joy of this comfort? (all) Three things: first, how great my sin and misery are; second, how I am set free from all my sins and misery; third, how I am to thank God for such deliverance

we confess . from the Valley of Vision Book of Puritan Prayers: "the broken heart"

(all) O Lord, not a day in my life has passed that has not proved me guilty in your sight. Prayers have been uttered from a prayerless heart; praise has been often praiseless sound. My best services are filthy rags. All things in me call for my rejection, and yet - all things in Christ plead my acceptance. I appeal from the throne of perfect justice to your throne of boundless grace. Grant me to hear your voice assuring me: that by your stripes I am healed, that you were made sin for me that I might be righteous in you, that my grievous sins are ALL forgiven, buried in the ocean of your concealing blood. I am guilty but pardoned, lost but saved, wandering but found, sinning but cleansed. O Christ, give me perpetual broken-heartedness, keep me always clinging to your cross, and flood the wilderness of my life with the river of your descending grace. Amen.
