we hear. from Ephesians 6:12, Romans 8:35-39

(leader) For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

we confess . adapted from Romans 7:18-25

(all) Lord, I know that nothing good dwells in me, in my flesh. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. I so often fail to do the good I want, but the evil I hate is what I keep on doing. Sin is busy at work in me. While I delight in your law of righteousness in my soul, I feel captive to the law of sin in my body. How wretched am I-who will deliver me from this body of death? Thanks be to God, through Jesus Christ our Lord!
