confessing our sin

God the Spirit reminds us that God the Father has saved us through the righteous life and sacrificial death of Christ the Son - and in faith we rest on his gracious interest to renew us yet again.

we hear. Romans 8:18-26

(leader) For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us. For the creation waits with eager longing for the revealing of the sons of God. For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of him who subjected it, in hope that the creation itself will be set free from its bondage to corruption and obtain the freedom of the glory of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation has been groaning together in the pains of childbirth until now. And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies. For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience. Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words.

we confess . prayer for mercy

(all) O merciful God, full of compassion and of great pity, who spares us from the fulness of suffering when we deserve punishment. Make us earnestly to repent. Make the remembrance of our sin so burdensome that we may flee to you with a troubled spirit and contrite heart. O merciful Lord, visit, comfort, and relieve us that we might live toward your glory and for grace toward others. Cast us not from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from us, but excite in us true repentance that receives the righteousness of Jesus. Amen.
